
consumerfraudreporting.org is a free online service to warn consumers about specific types of financial and other scams via the internet and provide a means to report scams and fraud. Do you know the signs?

- S** Stop! Don't share personal information!
- C** Caution! Verify strangers who claim to be family. Ask questions!
- A** Alert! Verify charities are a legit organization.
- M** Medical Alert! Only buy supplies from a reputable company!

- F** Fight Fraud! Prizes and sweepstakes don't require fees up front.
- R** Resist quick decisions! Don't be persuaded, reach out for a second opinion.
- E** End the call! The IRS, Social Security, and the Sheriff's office will not call you!
- E** Empowered Seniors are Scam free!
